This will be a time for musicians to safely get to know and interact with their peers and respective conductors in preparation for the season. Students will be chaperoned by GNOYO Staff, Counselors and the Music Director. The retreat is a mandatory element in the program that will enrich and nurture our GNOYO family.

3. Sunday September 19th, (10:00am-2:30pm): **Symphony** – orientation – ice breakers – sectional/orchestra rehearsals– team building activities – Lunch check out – **Symphony departs in mid afternoon**
